



Frequently Asked Questions

- Q. What happens if I do not raise \$5,000 minimum for the climb?
 A. Nothing, but we ask you to work as hard as you can to reach the minimum. If you are serious and creative you will make it. See "Keys to Successful Fundraising."
- Q. How is the money spent that I raise?
 A. 100% of the money goes to Child Legacy's water well refurbish/repair ministry.
- Q. What will we be doing in Malawi?
 A. We will stay at CLI's Sustainability Project Site. We will spend 2-4 days visiting villages primarily to repair their broken water wells and share the Gospel. We will also spend a day at the project site to work on miscellaneous activities.
- Q. How fit do I need to be to do the climb?
 A. VERY fit! We cannot underestimate this!
- Q. How should I go about raising support?
 A. To get support to go on the trip use the document "Sample Support Letters for Mission Trips" as a guide. I would send it to family to raise trip support.
- Q. What happens in case of life threatening emergency on the mountain or on the trip?
 A. If on the hike, the guide company will stretcher the person to a point of pick up by a helicopter or vehicle, depending on the severity of the situation. Let the trip leader and head guide know of any issue. If necessary, the person will be flown to Nairobi. If in Malawi, doctors on site will determine the necessary treatment and if the person should be flown to Nairobi or South Africa for care.
- Q. How will we be spending our time on the trip?
 A. Safari, Climb, Malawi Water wells – every day is jam-packed. There is a little R&R down time (1/2 day or so) after the climb when we get to Malawi.
- Q. What are the payment deadlines for the trip?
 A. See the corresponding trip flyer.
- Q. Any tips on how I can spiritually prepare for this trip?
 A. Pray on a daily basis for God to give you safety on the climb, prepare your heart and the hearts of the people you will serve in Malawi. Memorize, meditate, study, and discuss the 5 Bible stories.
