

## CLEAN WATER IS LIFE!

Because of *your* faithfulness, Child Legacy's *Clean Water Climb* accomplished the following in **2019**:

- **48** Climbers tackled Mt. Kilimanjaro, Mt. Mulanje, Everest Base Camp, Chimborazo, Appalachian Trail, and Mt. of the Holy Cross
- Nearly **\$400,000** raised for CLI's Clean Water program
- **311** wells repaired
- Over **310,000** Adults and **140,000** children received access to clean water
- Nearly **4,500** people gave their hearts to Christ

Since Child Legacy's *Clean Water Climb* was founded in 2011:

- **170** Climbers have tackled Mt. Kilimanjaro & other mountains
- Over **\$2.8 million** raised for CLI's Clean Water program

Child Legacy International was founded by Jeff and Karen Rogers in 1987, after years of experience in international aid and relief work led them to realize that meeting immediate needs was not enough to produce lasting change in the developing world. They designed and strategically implemented a Sustainable Program Development Model in rural Zimbabwe, offering healthcare, job training, education, and practical agricultural innovations — all 100% powered by renewable energy.

In 2007, Jeff and Karen Rogers moved to rural Malawi in order to replicate their Sustainable Program Development Model on a larger scale. In less than a decade, CLI's Malawi Campus has earned national recognition for its unique and effective approach to development, bringing real change to one of the poorest and least developed countries in the entire world.

### Child Legacy's Impact in Rural Malawi

- Nearly **300,000** rural patients treated for free, including over **5,000** infants safely delivered, via standard labor and emergency C-Section services
- Over **8.75** million people provided access to clean water through nationwide well repairs
- Over 125 acres of organic crops, 8 large tilapia ponds, and various livestock to promote food security and training for local farmers
- Hundreds trained via professional apprenticeship, plus a scholarship program for degrees in fields critical to the nation's development
- Nearly **60,000** salvations through church-planting, community outreach, and evangelism
- The first and only Community Hospital and Operating Theaters in the continent's region powered by 100% renewable energy
