**Outer Layers:** Fleece Jacket, Down Jacket, Waterproof Jacket with Hood, Waterproof Pants, 2 Trekking pants, 1 Short pants, Wide Brimmed Hat, Wool Hat, Insulated Gloves or mittens, Light Gloves

**Footwear:** Hiking Boots with Ankle support, Camp Shoes or Tennis Shoes (Plastic Bag to carry), 5-6 Pairs of Hiking Socks

**First Aid & Toiletries:** Personal Prescriptions, Advil, Moleskin for Blisters, Sunscreen, Lip Balm, Wet Wipes, Toilet Paper, Antibiotics, Soap, Deodorant, Brush, Towel, Hand Warmers, Ear plugs

**Misc:** Small Lock, Waterproof Cover for Daypack, Stuff sack for dirty clothes, Headlamp with extra Batteries, Sunglasses, Water Bottle, Waterproof bag for electronics, Charge adaptor, Snacks

**Paperwork & Money:** Passport, Spending Money for snacks and Beverages and Tips (Minimum \$100), Credit Card for Internet Purchases in Lodges (\$10 for 8 hours)
